Bacon & Spinach Quiche



- 6 large eggs, beaten
- 1 1/2 cups heavy cream
- salt and pepper
- 2 cups chopped fresh baby spinach, packed
- 1 pound bacon, cooked and crumbled
- 1 ½ cups shredded Cheddar or Swiss cheese
- 1 (9-in) refrigerated pie crust

Preheat oven to 375 degrees. Combine eggs, cream, salt and pepper. Layer the spinach, bacon, and cheese in the bottom of the pie crust, then pour the egg mixture on top. Bake for 35 to 45 minutes until the egg mixture is set.


