

Interconnection Process for Net-Metering Accounts



Customer requests Application and Net-Metering Agreement



Customer submits Application for review by Carroll Electric



Carroll Electric will notify customer of Application review results.



Some systems may require additional review.

If additional review is not required skip to **STEP 8**.

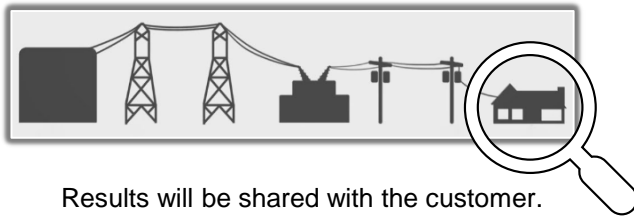


Carroll Electric will send Net-Metering Facility (NMF) Study Agreement to Customer.



The NMF Study Agreement must be signed and returned to Carroll Electric with the appropriate deposit.

Carroll Electric studies how net-metering facility will impact its electric grid.



Customer submits payment for necessary electric grid modifications (if applicable).



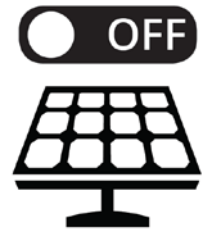
Carroll Electric modifies electric grid to accommodate net-metering facility (if applicable).



Customer obtains local permits required for net-metering facility installation (if applicable).



Net-metering facility is installed (but not turned on)



Local inspector completes inspection and endorses Net-Metering Agreement



Customer completes and returns Net-Metering Agreement for final review



Carroll Electric technician conducts safety inspection



Bi-directional meter is installed by Carroll Electric



Net-Metering Facility is turned on



Net-Metering Agreement is executed by Carroll Electric and a copy is returned to the Customer



Periodic safety inspections will be completed by a Carroll Electric technician



For customers of electric utilities, systems exceeding one thousand kilowatts (1,000 kW) for non-residential use must be approved by the Arkansas Public Service Commission before installation (A.C.A. § 23-18-603).
